Mr. Spoerl provided an overview of Aambe Corporation and the medical services that can be provided. The Ho-Chunk Nation has expressed interest in bringing medical options to Mayville. Mr. Spoerl explained options including prescription medication savings, occupational health options, and a potential medical clinic, as well as cost-savings opportunities. Mr. Spoerl answered questions from the Body clarifying that they have HIPAA compliance and are credentialed to take major insurance as well as medicare and medicaid. Mr. Spoerl further expressed that Aambe is committed to working with Mayville, in case a neighboring community tries to engage their services first. Next steps were discussed.
