The new ambulance will be purchased in 2027.



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Discuss Medical Control:

Continues to have Aurora Summit as medical control second to none, monthly trainings. Setting high standards for services. Required to attend quarterly training. Aurora is still not charging to be under their medical control. They cover about 60% of Dodge County, several services in Washington and Jefferson County.

Discuss Fundraising:

Yearly golf outing was in May; we were down teams this year. Golf course has been noticing that with other golf events. We were still able to fundraise \$7,000. We are looking at possibly looking at trap shoot as well. Building grant was discussed, our current building is old we have outgrown it.

Equipment Update-Ambulance Purchase:

We continue to fundraise and look for grants.

Discussed EMS training center. We are having another class starting next month. Training center has definitely impacted our service with attracting students wanting to run with us, which has improved our staffing.

Discussed call volume is increasing.
