2.a Approval of Minutes of the February 23, 2026, Finance Committee Meeting

The motion to approve the minutes of the February 23, 2026, Finance Committee meeting was made by Ald. Smith and seconded by Ald. Henkel.

4. DISCUSS WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

4.a Discuss, with Possible Recommendation, Setting a Reduced Rate for TAG Center Memberships for Surrounding Communities

Mayor Boelk provided background for this agenda item. He informed the body that he is looking to potentially offer a reduced rate to the TAG Center to surrounding communities to boost membership. He added that Horicon has already showed interest. Ald. Smith indicated this has been brought up in past years. He inquired if there are any legal ramifications, as the TAG Center is subsidized annually in some capacity by the City of Mayville tax payers. Ald. Henkel asked about the possibility of reciprocal services between communities. Ald. Neumann expressed interest in potentially offering a reduced County rate.

The motion to table this matter to the April Finance Committee meeting was made by Ald. Henkel and seconded by Ald. Smith.

Vote: 3 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

4.b Discuss, with Possible Recommendation, Leasing of City-Owned Forestry Property for Bow Hunting Rights

Mayor Boelk provided background for this agenda item. He indicated there is interest in bow hunting on the City-owned land that runs along the river, behind the Water Wastewater Treatment Facility, near the north industrial park. He is proposing issuing a request for proposals for a 3-year lease allowing hunting rights. The leasee would be able to have up to ten (10) hunters on the land. The attorney edited lease agreement and liability waiver were in the packet for review.

The motion to recommend Common Council approve the leasing of city-owned forestry property for bow hunting rights was made by Ald. Henkel and seconded by Ald. Neumann.

Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays, 1 abstain (Ald. Smith). Motion carried.

4.c Discuss, with Possible Recommendation, 2025 Fund Balance Rollover to the 2026 Budget

Comptroller/Treasurer DeBaker provided background for this agenda item, going over the memo she provided to the Body. She added that she is seeking to make a \$1,322,135 reduction to the 2025 budget and add it to the 2026 budget, due to the timing of a few of the 2025 budgeted items, including DPW plow truck, DPW storm sewer updates, police department furniture, and project costs in TID #7.

The motion to recommend Common Council approve the presented budget amendment was made by Ald. Smith and seconded by Ald. Neumann.

Subject: Overnight Weekday Stipend Adjustment

Overview:

The current overnight on-call rate of \$2.86 per hour has contributed to ongoing staffing challenges, as overnight shifts have become increasingly difficult to fill. To support consistent service coverage and provide a reasonable incentive for staff to accept and pick up overnight assignments, it is recommended that the overnight on-call rate be adjusted to \$3.50 per hour.

Financial Impact:

The proposed stipend increase applies to weekday overnight shifts only (Monday–Friday). Each overnight shift is six (6) hours in length, with an estimated 260 overnight shifts annually.
